## LING

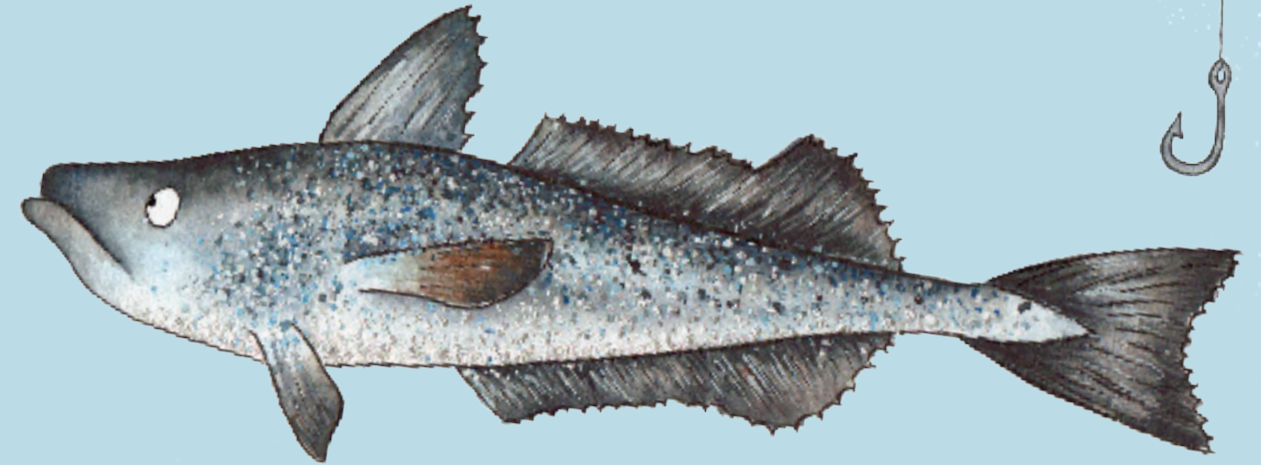
I have a long body with brown and white spotty skin. Can you find me?
